HOMEBOYKRIS was well placed just behind the leaders for a half, edged closer while three wide on the turn, kept ASPIRE trapped along the inside in upper stretch, made a run to challenge inside the furlong marker, took the lead leaving the sixteenth pole and edged clear under steady left hand urging. DISCREETLY MINE pressed the pace from outside for a half, edged closer on the turn, took the lead leaving the quarter pole, battled gamely into midstretch and yielded grudgingly. ASPIRE settled just off the early pace along the inside, saved ground behind the leaders leaving the turn, was boxed in at the three-sixteenths pole, altered course to the outside to get clear in midstretch and rallied belatedly. SUPER SAVER set the pace under pressure along the rail to the top of the stretch, fought heads apart into midstretch and weakened late. DUBLIN was reserved for a half, drifted five wide at the quarter pole then lacked a strong closing response. OVERLAP trailed along the rail throughout.
